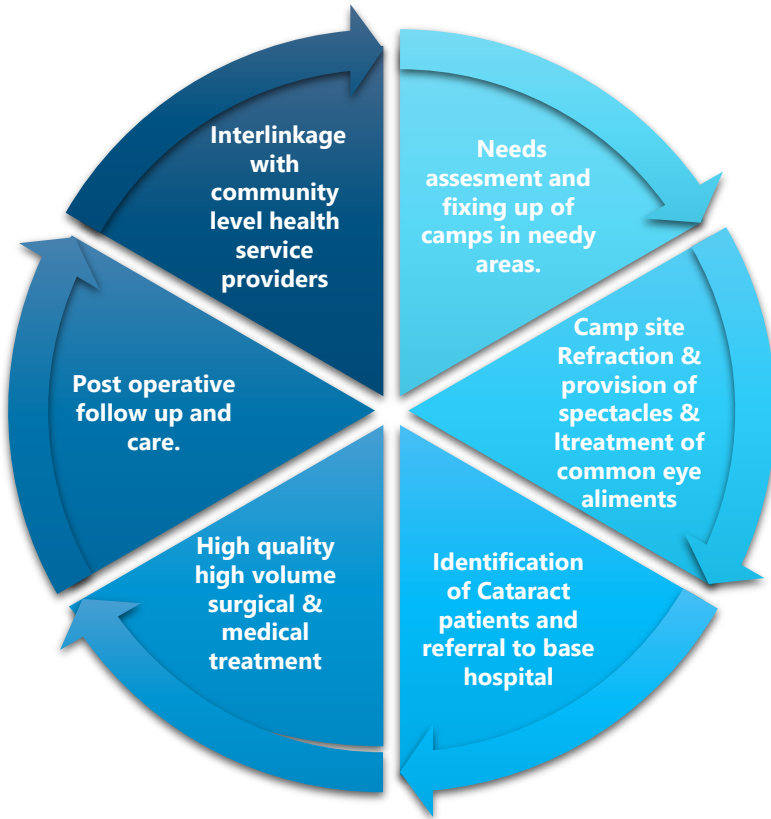

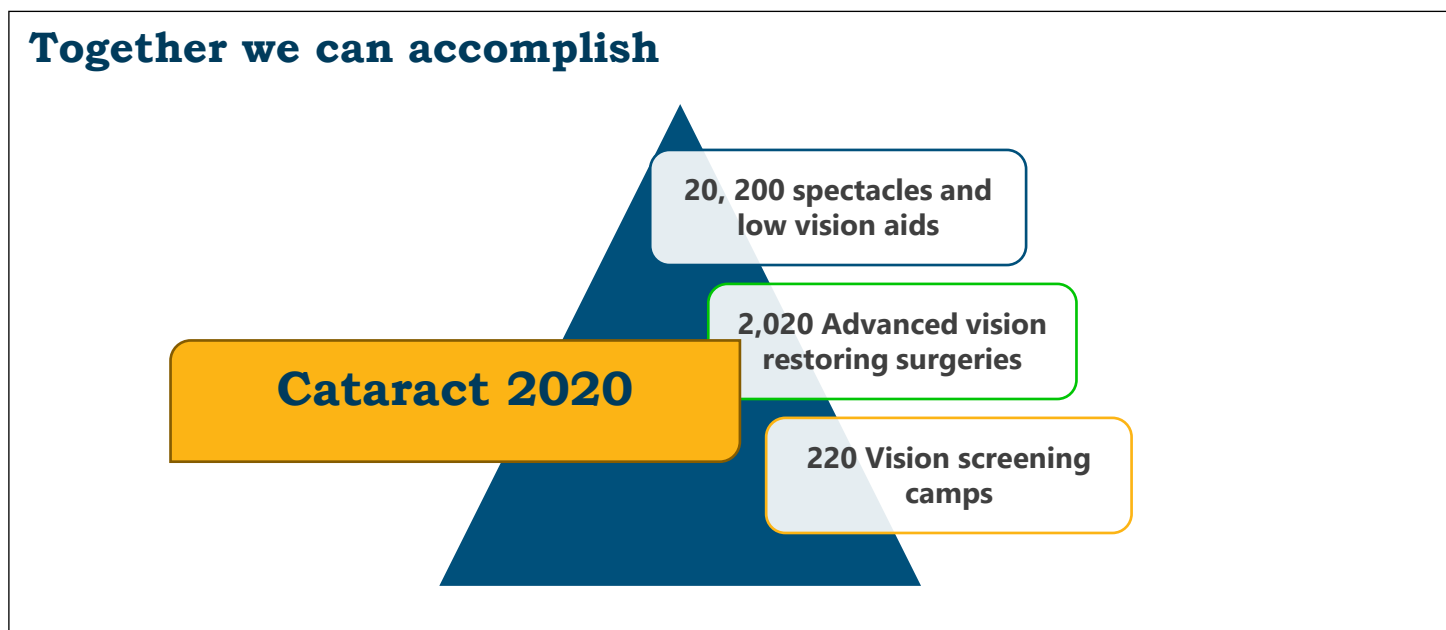
Best of quality care - be it Paying or Outreach patients

India's fight against needless blindness started over 40 years ago, first in the world to do so. In 1999, WHO and IAPB collectively launched the vision 2020, to eliminate preventable blindness by 2020. Today prevalence of blindness in India has decreased by 47%. JMF has humbly contributed in this fight with its community outreach and quality vision care since 2001.

However, the mission to eliminate blindness needs to go stronger than ever. Blindness and particularly Cataract, continues to afflict 2% of the population above 50 years and is the second major cause of severe visual impairment in the population below 50 years in India. (NPCB survey 2019).

2020: milestone year when as a country, we strive to reduce blindness prevalence to 0.3%.

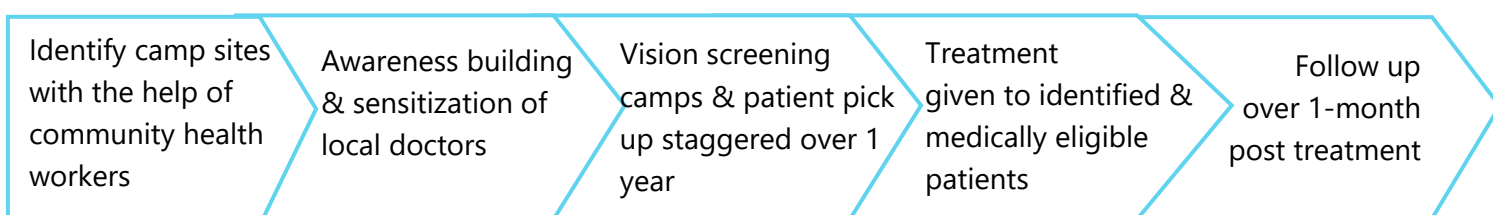
As always, JMF team aims to lead this mission from the front.



JMF envisages reaching out to over 50,000 people in need of eye care in the rural and semi urban areas of North Karnataka in the year 2020 to help elimination of preventable blindness. JMF's outreach and medical team will aim to screen 200 villages for Cataract, Diabetic retinopathy and other major ailments.

- ✈ To establish community based, sustainable and quality oriented eye care centre.
