Jayapriya Medical Foundation (JMF) is a non-profit organization that works to provide best-in-class and affordable eye care, accessible to rural areas spread across North Karnataka.

In 2002, Dr. Shrikrishna G. Nadgouda started JMF as a small initiative to enable vision care services to the impoverished and underserved sections of society. Over the years, the organization has evolved to reach out to more than one crore population primarily residing in rural areas of Northern Karnataka: Dharwad, Haveri, Belgaum, Gadag, Bagalkot and Koppal.

The organization so far conducted more than 1000 free medical camps, examined more than 10 Lakhs patients, performed more than 60,000 sight-saving cataract surgeries, distributed free medicines and gave other eye care services to more than 6 Lakhs people in underserved communities. All these surgeries have been performed at zero expense to patients.

JMF aims to set benchmarks in all aspects of ophthalmic care delivery to the patients and the public. Guidance is provided for all types of eye disorders and the services are reviewed regularly to keep them aligned with changing demands and technology.

We have been recognized under Section 80G of income tax, Section 12A of income tax and FCRA Registration for receiving foreign funds. 


